We are open and continuing to run our classes as normal, however we would like to reassure all of our members and staff that we are regularly reviewing the advice being given from Public Health England, NHS, British Gymnastics and the Government. Please be assured that the health and welfare of our members, parents and staff is our main priority.

At this stage it is not necessary to cancel any of our classes and we intend to stay open until government intervention and will keep everyone informed should any new information arise.

SGA Preventative measures:

- It is now MANDATORY that every child washes their hands before entering the gym and after lessons. This also stands for any parents that stay in the corridor as well please. We have now added footstools for you her gymnast who cannot reach the taps.
- Hand sanitisers and soaps will be accessible outside of the gym hall door at both our Lingfield and Edenbridge sites for our members and parents to use
- We have increased the frequency of cleaning procedures in regards to our gym equipment and staff will wash their hands between class changeovers.
- The prime minister has advised that if anyone in your household has a cough or temperature, everyone in the household must self isolate for 7 days.
- If anyone who has visited our gym has self isolated please inform us as soon as possible.
